Road Safety Sub-component Transport Sector Programme Support, Phase 2

The overall objective was to reduce road accident rates in Ghana. The immediate objective was to develop the capacity and competence of Ghanaian institutions to effectively implement the Government's road safety policy in order to achieve targets of reduced road accidents without the continuous need for external assistance.

The Technical Assistance to the sub-component comprised:

- Assistance to the Road Safety and Environment Division of Ghana Highway Authority
- Assistance to the National Road Safety Commission (NRSC).

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Assistance to Ghana Highway Authority:

- Review of existing road design standards/guidelines to enhance roadway safety
- Work zone safety management

guidelines

- New standards for signs and markings
- Improved capability to carry out preventative as well as remedial engineering road safety works
- Training of engineers in road safety.

Assistance to NRSC:

- Improved capability to initiate, fund and execute road safety campaigns
- Better training of school children in road safety
- Preparation of material for school teachers and school children for enhanced road safety education in schools
- Improved stakeholder networks and forums for dialogue
- Funding systems and institutional support schemes for regional branches of NRSC
- Road safety regulations examined and revisions proposed
- Support the development of a National Road Safety Policy.
